Tell me about yourself: I like drawing and doing art lessons. I use Pen and pencil to do my artwork.

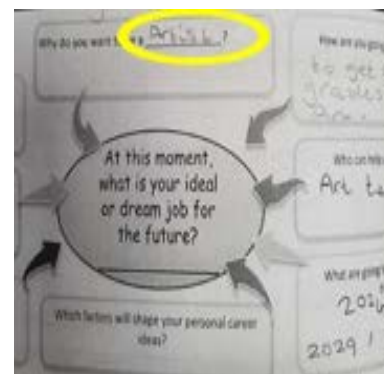
What is your favourite subject? I love doing Art lessons because Mrs Cooper makes the lessons so fun—we like making a mess!

One challenge since joining Lyng Hall School? Probably my English lessons that I am finding a bit hard, at the moment.

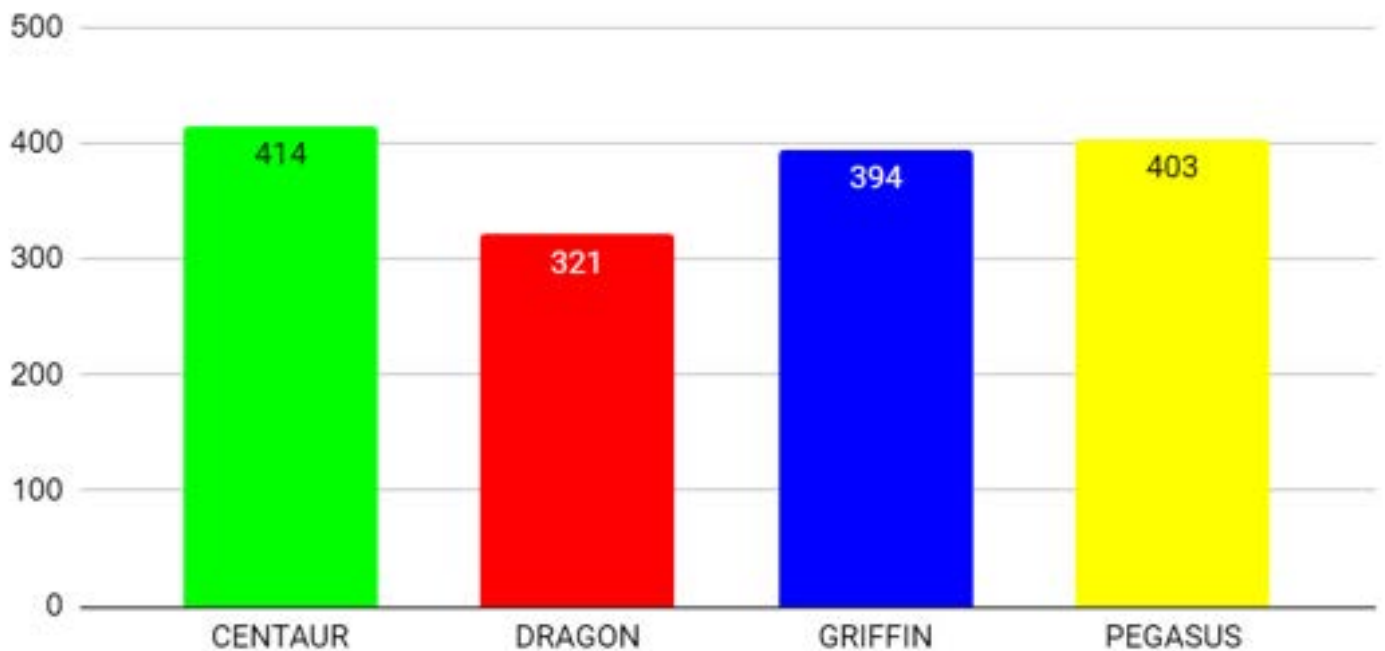
Who do you want to be in the future? Maybe like an Art career. In my PSHE booklet I put down being an Art teacher.

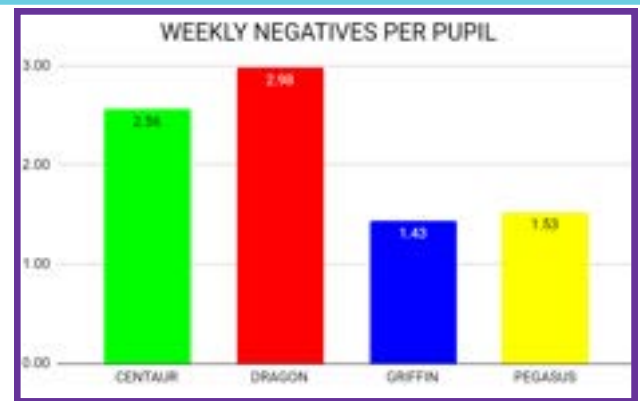
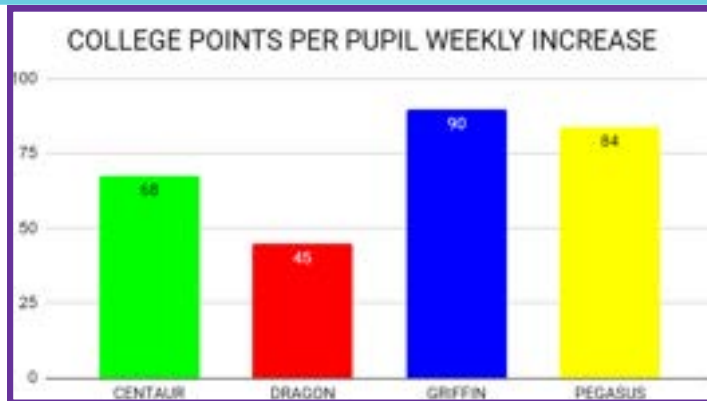
College – Update

Miss Gaggini is surprised that the other colleges seem to be 'giving-it-up' to Griffin, with very little competition. Griffin were our college championship winners last year but, there are lots of pupils deserving of a first-place win. Dragon started off in third place but have already allowed themselves to drop to the bottom of the league, with quite a considerable gap between them and Griffin. Dragon are the only college to have never won the championship and this is a real shame, as so many Dragon pupils work hard to earn their college positive points. Unfortunately, the high number of negative points from only a few of the pupils in Dragon college, are what hold their team at the bottom of league.
