Creative I Media	 Students are completing their second component in their coursework this term focusing on Developing Digital Media Production Skills. This element of the course is out of 60 marks and broken down into 5 tasks. This work will go towards their final grade. The learning topics students will focus on this term are: Developing planning skills and idea generation documents. Using digital design software to create a product. Editing images and understanding a media brief. Understanding how to reflect and improve a concept.
